Treasurer's Report – Rebecca Van Wyck, Treasurer

Request for Additional Funds for end of Year BBQ by Ryan Snow and Karen Quintieri. Funds are required because MIR is unable to match the Funds that PTA had allocated for the event, however, could donate up to \$500 if necessary.

A discussion about the possibility of requesting a donation of \$1 per student was brought up by Mrs. Cote. The re-allocation of unused teachers' expenditures money was also discussed. Ultimately, a motion to allocate \$750 from roll over fund to End of the Year BBQ was made by Karen Quintieri, and second by Ryan Snow. The motion passed with 10 votes.

New Business

- **Principal's Search** - Amanda Mack, PTA President stated that she received a call from the District's office to explain to her the process of the principal search. She was told the committee would have 10 people, the district wanted to know if the PTA had any objection to the parents chosen to be part of the committee. Discussed the issue of selecting a PTA rep for principal search. The school's staff chose 2 parents to be part of the committee; however, parents feel that both MIR and PTA should have a part in the process. MIR has chosen Maria as their rep; Caitlin Jacksic nominates Karen Quintieri as the PTA rep. in this meeting.

This is why he is suggesting a Skate-a-thon next year; some of the major benefits of this activity is that the moneys raised stay at the school unlike with other types of fundraisers where a portion of the money made goes back to the companies that sponsor it. The Skate-a-thon's success depends on Incentives and prices. Mr. Young is willing to co-chair a committee if he has a couple of parents' helpers. Mr. Young states he would be happy collecting 25% of the overall earnings with the rest going to computer lab and 6th grade camp for example. The plan is to talk with new principal first, following with the first committee meeting in September of 2018. Marin Granholm indicated that "I am very interested in this. "I want to run the ice-cream feast."
